

Minnesota Department of Natural Resources – Environmental Review Process Timeline for the Twin Metals Minnesota Project

December 18, 2019

Below is an overview of the various phases of the environmental review process, including a note of where we currently are, as of December 18, 2019.

We are currently at the beginning of the variable timeframe: prepare scoping environmental assessment worksheet (EAW) and draft scoping decision

Minimum of 30 days: public scoping comment period and public meeting

Minimum of six weeks: final scoping decision

Variable timeframe: draft environmental impact statement (EIS) preparation

Minimum of 45 days: draft EIS public comment period and public meeting

Variable timeframe: final EIS preparation

Minimum of two weeks: final EIS public comment period

Variable timeframe: determination of EIS adequacy
